Blood group test. To work out your blood group, your red cells are mixed with different antibody solutions. If, for example, the solution contains anti-B antibodies and you have B antigens on your cells (you're blood group B), it will clump together. If the blood does not react to any of the anti-A or anti-B antibodies, it's blood group O.
